1. Name of Work

Hiring of One Hydraulic Excavator 215 L on Hourly Basis at Tilaboni Coal Mine of ECL.

2. Scope of Work

The Contractor shall provide one Hydraulic Excavator of 215 L along with operator and diesel for deployment at JMS Tilaboni Project on hourly hiring basis.

The scope of work shall include:

- Deployment of one Hydraulic Excavator 215 L with bucket and all standard accessories.
- Provision of experienced and licensed operator in 3 shifts of 8 hours each.
- Fuel, lubricants, maintenance, repairs and consumables shall be arranged by the Contractor at its own cost.
- The machine shall be made available as per the requirement of the Project.
- In case of breakdown, the Contractor shall arrange a replacement machine of equivalent capacity immediately to avoid disruption of operations.
- The Contractor shall maintain the machine in good operating condition throughout the contract period.
- The Contractor shall ensure minimum monthly machine availability of 90%. Any availability below 90% shall attract proportionate deduction at double the applicable hourly rate for the shortfall period.
- Hour meter readings shall be jointly recorded at the beginning and end of each shift in a logbook signed by authorized representatives of both parties. JMS records shall be final and binding.
- JMS may require replacement of any operator found unsuitable on grounds of misconduct, safety violations, incompetence or indiscipline. Such replacement shall be effected within 24 hours.
- The Contractor shall comply with all provisions relating to wages, EPF, ESI, Bonus, Gratuity, Minimum Wages and Labour Codes. Any liability arising due to non-compliance shall be solely borne by the Contractor and may be recovered by JMS from pending bills.

- The Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified JMS, ECL and their officials against all claims, losses, damages, penalties, accidents, injuries, statutory liabilities and legal proceedings arising out of execution of the contract.
- JMS may suspend operation of the machine temporarily due to operational, statutory, environmental or safety reasons without any compensation except payment for actual utilized hours.
- The contract is purely on hourly hiring basis and JMS does not guarantee any minimum number of operating hours during the contract period.
- Bidder shall be deemed to have inspected the site and understood local conditions, terrain, access roads, safety requirements and operational constraints before submission of bid. No claim on this account shall be entertained subsequently.

3. Contract Period

The contract shall remain valid for 6 (Six) months.

The Company reserves the right to extend the contract period for further six months on the same terms and conditions.

4. Eligibility Criteria

The bidder shall satisfy the following minimum eligibility criteria:

- Experience in Excavator Hiring / Mining / Construction works.
- Ownership of the Excavator or valid lease agreement in respect of the offered machine.
- Valid PAN, GST Registration and Bank Account details.
- Declaration confirming that the bidder has not been blacklisted by any Government Department, PSU or Private Organization.

5. Technical Requirements

The offered Excavator shall comply with the following:

- Hydraulic Excavator – 215 L Class.
- Year of manufacture shall not be older than 2 (Two) years from the date of submission of bid.
- Machine shall be fitted with Hour meter.
- The machine shall be maintained in excellent working condition.
- All statutory documents including Registration, Insurance and Pollution Certificate shall remain valid throughout the contract period.

6. Bid Submission

The bids shall be submitted in two parts:

A. Technical Bid

The Technical Bid shall contain:

- Company/Firm Profile.
- Experience details.
- Ownership/Lease documents of Excavator.
- PAN and GST Registration Certificates.
- Bank Details.
- Declaration regarding non-blacklisting.
- Technical specifications of the machine.
- Copy of Registration Certificate, Insurance and other statutory documents.
- Licence copies of operators
- Audited Financial Statements and ITR of last three years.

B. Financial Bid

The Financial Bid shall contain:

- Hourly hiring charges of the Excavator. The quoted rates shall remain firm during the contract period.
- The quoted rates shall be inclusive of operator charges, fuel, lubricants, maintenance, repairs and all other incidental expenses, excluding GST.

- Certified operating hour statement.

- Daily logbook containing operating hours and start & closing meter readings
- Statutory compliance documents as applicable.
- Wage register, bank payment details, all labour compliance documents

8. Safety Compliance

The Contractor shall comply with all applicable:

- Mine Safety Rules.
- DGMS Guidelines.
- Labour Codes.
- Environmental and Safety regulations of the Project.

The Contractor shall provide all Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to its employees.

9. Insurance

The Contractor shall maintain adequate insurance coverage for:

- Operator – GPA of Rs 25 lakhs with medical rider of Rs 2 lakhs
- Third-party liabilities – Rs 50 lakhs

10. Company's Right

JMS Tilaboni Private Limited reserves the right to:

- Accept or reject any bid;
- Cancel the tender wholly or partially;
- Split the work among one or more bidders;
- Modify the tender conditions at any stage before award of contract without assigning any reason.

11. Jurisdiction
